Help USDA Pilot Acreage Reporting Initiative in Your County Today!



The pilot project is part of the **Acreage Crop Reporting Streamlining Initiative (ACRSI)** as a way for producers to submit acreage reports to USDA just once. Acreage crop reporting is an important step farmers and ranchers take to be eligible for many USDA programs and services, such as federal crop insurance administered by the Risk Management Agency (RMA) and farm programs administered by the Farm Service Agency (FSA).

In this pilot project, producers will use their precision ag data equipment to provide their 2019 wheat acreage to USDA agencies. The data is processed by an approved third party provider and transmitted directly to FSA and RMA.

Participating Nebraska County Offices

Box Butte, Cheyenne, Dawes-North Sioux, Frontier, Furnas, Harlan, Hayes, Hitchcock, Keith, Kimball, Lincoln, Morrill, Perkins, Red Willow, Sheridan, and Webster.

Producers will have to visit their participating FSA County Office and Crop Insurance Agency to validate transmitted data, sign the final acreage reports and provide any additional information.
